6 : What main function is provided to all versions of Microsoft Windows by the Windows Driver Model (WDM)?

Correct Answer : WDM is a technology developed by Microsoft to create drivers that are source-code compatible for a number of Windows operating systems, including Windows 10. WDM works by channeling some of the work of the device driver into portions of the code that are integrated into the operating system. The WDM device driver becomes more streamlined with less code and works at greater efficiency.

7 : If you are studying to become a system administrator, why is it important to learn how to use the different command line interfaces available in most operating systems?

Correct Answer : When you are studying to become an administrator, you need to perform your tasks as efficiently as possible. Using the command line is efficient once you learn the commands. When administrating a Microsoft Windows server, the command-line interface is sometimes the proper tool.

8 : What is the basic idea behind open source software?

Correct Answer : When programmers can read, redistribute, and modify the source code for a piece of software, the software evolves. People improve it, adapt it, and fix bugs in it, often at astonishing speeds compared with the slow pace of conventional software development.

9 : What role does the virtual file system (VFS) perform within the CentOS 7 kernel?

Correct Answer : The VFS abstracts the details of the various hardware devices by presenting a common file interface to all devices. In addition, the VFS supports several file system formats that are compatible with other operating systems.

10 : What functions are provided by the Memory Manager (MM) within the CentOS 7 kernel?

Correct Answer : The MM permits multiple processes to securely share the machine's main memory system. In addition, the memory manager supports virtual memory that allows CentOS 7 to support processes that use more memory than is available in the system.

11 : What is multithreading and why is it advantageous?

Correct Answer : With multithreading (multiple threads executed in parallel), a program splits into two or more tasks that run simultaneously. A common use of threads is to have one pay attention to the graphical user interface while others do a long calculation in the background. As a result, the application more readily responds to a user's interaction.

12 : How does the operating system use paging to enhance the use of memory?

Correct Answer : To maximize its flexibility in managing memory, the OS can move pages of physical memory to and from a paging file onto a disk. When a page is moved into physical memory, the OS updates the page maps of the affected processes. When the OS needs space in physical memory, it moves the least recently used pages of physical memory to the paging file. The manipulation of physical memory by the OS is completely transparent to applications, which operate only in their virtual address spaces.

13 : Name and describe the system utility in Windows 10 that can be used to manage your system's hard drives and partitions.

Correct Answer : Disk Management is a system utility for managing hard drives and the partitions they contain. With Disk Management, you can initialize disks, create partitions, and format volumes with file systems such as exFAT, FAT32, or NTFS.

14 : Describe the functionality provided by the Processes tab within Task Manager in Windows 10.

Correct Answer : You can use the Processes tab to view the names of applications that are running and the background processes running on the computer. The tab displays usage statistics for the processor (CPU), memory, disks, and networks. You can then use this information to troubleshoot problems by determining which programs are using the most resources, such as processing or memory.

15 : Provide a high-level description of the CentOS 7 System Monitor.

Correct Answer : You can use System Monitor to review process activity in real time. The utility

displays a list of the most CPU-intensive tasks on the PC. System Monitor contains more tabs than just the Processes tab; it also contains Resources and File Systems tabs. From the Resources tab, you can review real-time information about CPU history, memory and swap history, and network history.
